1. General information.

1.1. Executive Director: Litvinchuk Vladislav.

1.2. Organizers: Nordijsko društvo Rateče-Planica and SPORTHUB d.o.o.

1.3. The International Cross-country skiing event PLANICA SKI MARATHON on 01-02 of February, 2025 in Nordic centre Planica on track Rateče-Planica.

1.4. Distances:

Skate (01.02.25): 42 km (3 x 12,5 km in 5 km), 21 km (1 x 12,5 km in 9 km), 10 km, 5 km, kids race (details on the website <https://planicaski.com>).

Classic (02.02.25): 21 km (1 x 12,5 km in 9 km), 10 km, 5 km.

1.5. Control time of distance passing: 21 Km – 2 hours 30 min, 42 Km - 4 hours 30 min.

1.6. Registration on the official website: <https://planicaski.com>.

1.7. Maximum number of Participants: 580, distribution by distance: kids race – 30; 5 km – 100; 10 km – 150; 21 km – 200; 42 Km – 100.

1.8. 3 winners from "Men" and "Women" in the overall standing at 21 and 42 km are subject to awarding.

The number of categories for awarding can be increased at the judgment of the Organizer.

1.9. Cases not considered in the Regulations are considered by the Organizing Committee in the current order.

2. Goals and objectives.

2.1. Popularization of a healthy lifestyle and cross-country skiing.

2.2. Attracting tourists among sports fans to the region.

2.3. Stimulating the growth of sports achievements in long-distance cross-country skiing.

3. The manual.

Organizers: Nordijsko društvo Rateče-Planica and SPORTHUB d.o.o.

The management of the marathon is carried out by the Organizing Committee.

4. Place and time of the event.

4.1. The schedule of the event is published on the official website (clause 1.6) together with the appointment of the start time.

4.2. The courses is posted on the website.

4.3. The Organizers have the right to change the courses and the start time by notifying the Participants on the website (clause 1.6). The decision on the change is made by the Director of the start, taking into account snow conditions, air temperature, as well as orders of supervisory agencies, security services and other state services.

5. Participants of the competition.

- 5.1. Age restriction: 42 km – 2007 year of birth and older; 21 km - 2009 year of birth and older; 10 km - 2013 year of birth and older; 5 km - 2016 year of birth and older. Kids race - 2017 year of birth and younger.
- 5.2. The age group of the Participant is determined by the number of full years as of December 31, 2025.
- 5.3. The maximum total number of swim Participants is specified in paragraph 1.7. The Organizers have the right, but do not obligate to increase or decrease the number of Participants.

6. Registration.

- 6.1. Registration is made online on the official website (clause 1.6). If you have not received confirmation of registration by email or in your personal account, contact the Organizers.
- 6.2. Registration will be open until the total number of Participants is reached (clause 1.7) (counting all distances and age groups). If there are significantly more people willing to participate, the Organizers reserve the right, but do not obligate, to revise this paragraph of the Regulations.
- 6.3. When registering, the Participant is obliged to provide personal data in accordance with the identity document.
- 6.4. A participant is considered registered if he has filled out the registration form and paid the registration fee.
- 6.5. The registration fee is spent on organizational needs. The amount of the contribution can be found on the official website (p.1.6). All financial issues are regulated by the offer agreement published on the website.
- 6.6. The paid registration fee is not refundable.
- 6.7. The registration of the Participant is cancelled if the Participant provides false, inaccurate or incomplete data. In case of cancellation of registration, the funds will not be refunded.
- 6.8. The transfer of paid participation to other persons is regulated by the Offer Agreement posted on the website.
- 6.9 By registering, the Participant confirms his agreement with all the clauses of this Regulations and the public offer agreement.

7. Admission to competitions.

- 7.1. In order to be admitted to the competition and receive a starter kit before the start, Participants must provide:
- Passport or other identity document.
- 7.2. To be allowed to compete at the kids race and receive a starter kit before the start, Participants must provide:
- A parent's passport or a child's birth certificate.

7.3. All points of this section are mandatory, failure to comply with any of them entails the removal of the Participant from the competition without any compensation.

8. Starter kit and chip.

8.1. Time measurement is performed at all distances (except kids race).

8.2. The starter kit includes:

- individual bib number;
- informational materials.

8.3. Participants are allowed to start only with an electronic chip (when using electronic timekeeping) and a bib number given by the Organizers. The chip should be secured in accordance with the instructions of the Organizers. Incorrect fixing of the chip can make it impossible to fix an individual result. At the end of the race, the chip must be handed over to the Organizers.

8.4. Starter kits are given during registration only to the Participant personally. Receiving packages for other persons and transferring packages to other persons is prohibited.

9. Awarding.

9.1. Participants are to be awarded in accordance with clause 1.8.

9.2. Age categories:

9.3. All finishers within the time limit are awarded a finisher's medal.

9.4. The participants who took the prize in the absolute do not participate in the awarding in age groups.

9.5. Awarding by age groups is carried out on the condition that 4 participants or more are declared in the group. With a smaller number of participants, the older group is combined with the younger one for participants over 18 years old. For participants under 17 years old, the younger group is combined with the older one.

9.6. In case of non-appearance of an athlete for the awards ceremony, the prizes remain at the disposal of the organizers.

10. Withdrawal from the race.

10.1. If a Participant decides to interrupt the competition, he must inform the Organizers about it and return the electronic chip, this can be done in the starting area or at the starting point. The exact location of the starting area and the starting point are indicated on the website (p. 1.6).

10.2. The medical staff, Organizers and judges of the competition have the right to withdraw the Participant from the track at any time if they deem it necessary.

11. Disqualification.

11.1. The Organizers have the right to disqualify a Participant if they have reasonable concerns for his health, if the Participant does not comply with the rules of the competition and the conditions of this Provision, interferes with other Participants, otherwise hinders the competition.

11.2. The control time is valid at distances. The participant is removed from the race if he does not fit into the allotted time limit.

11.3. The participant is removed from the race if he does not have control points. The Organizers explain the rules for passing the control points at the pre-start briefing.

11.4. Each Participant during the race must wear a bib given by the Organizers.

12. Ensuring security.

12.1. The overall responsibility for ensuring security lays on the Organizer.

12.4. Medical support is provided by ambulances with the necessary equipment in accordance with the regulatory legal acts in force on the territory of the race.

12.5. The safety of Participants and spectators at the venue of the main events of the race on land is provided by the Organizer through the hiring of a private security company (PSC).

12.6. The Organizers are not responsible for the Participants who do not comply with the rules of the race and the instructions of the Organizers.

13. Photo and video shooting.

13.1. The Organizer has the right, without any notification, compensation to the Participant or liability, to make a photo and video recording of the Participant during the race, to use photo, audio and / or video materials with the participation of the race Participant in promotional, advertising and other publications in the printing industry, on radio, television, the Internet and other sources without limitation of the terms and places of use of these materials, as well as the right to edit such materials and transfer them to third parties.

14. Personal data.

14.1. The fulfilment by the race Participant of payment actions of the registration fee automatically means the full and unconditional acceptance (accept) by the race Participant of the terms of the public contract-offer, including agreement on the processing of their personal data by the Organizer.

14.2. When filling out the registration web-form for the Event, the race Participant provides the Organizer with the following information, which is the personal data of the race Participant: surname, first name, patronymic, gender, date of birth, contact information (phone, email, city), company, club, phone of a relative to whom it possible to contact in case of an accident with a Participant. When filling out an application for participation in the Event, the race Participant provides the Organizer with information about passport data.

14.3. Personal data processing means: collection, systematization, accumulation, clarification, updating, modification, use, distribution, transfer, including cross-border, depersonalization, blocking, destruction, storage, and any other actions (operations) with personal data. The processing of personal data of the race Participant can be carried out with the help of automation tools and / or without the use of automation tools in accordance with the current legislation on the territory of the race.

14.4. The processing of personal data of the race Participant is carried out solely for the purpose of fulfilling the terms of this public offer agreement and the Regulations on the race, including for registration of the race Participant for the Event, formation of start and finish protocols, sending e-mail messages and SMS notifications to the race Participant containing information about the Event and any other information, concerning the Participant of the race and related to the Event.

14.5. The Organizer takes the necessary legal, organizational and technical measures or ensures their adoption to protect personal data from unauthorized or accidental access to them, destruction, modification, blocking, copying, provision, dissemination of personal data, as well as from other illegal actions with respect to personal data, and also undertakes to maintain the confidentiality of personal data Participants of the race. The Organizer has the right to involve subcontractors for the processing of personal data of race Participants, and also has the right to transfer personal data for processing to its affiliates (the list of persons is kept by the Organizer's representatives and can be provided to the Participant upon request), while ensuring that such subcontractors and affiliates accept the corresponding obligations regarding the confidentiality of personal data.

14.6. The date of issue of consent to the processing of personal data of the race Participant is the completion by the race Participant of actions to pay the cost of the registration fee. The consent is valid for 20 (twenty) years from the date of transfer of personal data transfer.

14.7. Consent to the processing of personal data may be revoked by a race Participant on the basis of a written application in any form addressed to the Organizer and sent to him at: info@planicaski.com.

15. Protests.

15.1. Claims based on the results of the race are accepted during the day of the race and two days after the race.

15.2. If the Organizers have doubts about the validity of the claim, the claim is sorted out after the deposit of 20 Euro. The deposit is refunded if the assumptions set out in the claim are confirmed.

15.3. The protocols of the race can be specified within three days after the race, after that they are considered official and final.

This Regulations may be changed or terminated by the Organizers unilaterally without prior notice to the Participants and without payment of any compensation in this regard.

This Regulations is an official invitation-call to participate in the Race.
